Art Center Padula cancellations due to Covid-19

Should a workshop have to be canceled due to Government health directive, any student enrolled in that workshop will be contacted and a refund will be arranged.

COVID requirements for traveling to or residing in Italy

Cancellation, Refund and Transfer Policy

Should a class have to be canceled for any reason, such as insufficient enrolments, any student enrolled in that class will be contacted and an alternative class, credit or refund arranged.

Refunds

Fees are refundable, depending on the time remaining until workshop commencement, and except for the deposit amount of \$500.00.

Cancellation by participants

If you choose to cancel a class, what you will receive back depends on the time you notify Art Center Padula. See our cancellation timeframes and options below:

Cancellations up to 2 months before class commencement

If you choose to withdraw from a course or workshop more than two months before workshop start, a full refund, minus the deposit amount, will be made in case of cancellation by the participant.

• Cancellations up to 1 month before of class commencement If you choose to withdraw from a workshop less than two months but more than

If you choose to withdraw from a workshop less than two months but more that one month before workshop start, you will be eligible for a 50% refund, minus the deposit amount.

• Cancellations within one month (30 days) of class commencement No refunds will be made for cancellation in the month preceding the start of the workshop, regardless of the reason.

The above mentioned periods may differ slightly per workshop. If so, exact information for cancellation is provided in the registration module for a particular workshop. We strongly advise our participants to procure cancellation insurance to cover costs not included in the workshop fee.

Cancellation by Art Center Padula
